## Temple Bar Regatta race 2 of 2 for the Ostrom Cup

### 1. Venue

The Nevada Yacht Club (NYC) will be holding its Temple Bar Regatta race 2 of 2 for the Ostrom Cup which will consist of two race days on Lake Mead. The race schedule will be as follows:

Temple Bar Day 1	Saturday, October 8, 2022	8:00 AM	9:00 AM
Temple Bar Day 2	Sunday, October 9, 2022	8:00 AM	9:00 AM

Competitors meeting will be held on the patio of Lake Mead Marina. Day 1 will be the formal competitor's meeting. Day 2 will consist of a regroup and course clarification.

### 2. Rules

NYC's Temple Bar Fall Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of PHRF, and the Sailing Instructions (SI).

### 3. Eligibility and Classes

The races are open to all competitors with boats meeting the requirements of the Southern California PHRF by-laws. The fleets consist of:

- "A" Fleet which consists of having a PHRF up to/including 149.
- "B" Fleet which consists of having a PHRF of 150 and above.
- **Both fleets race against each other with one winner**

The rating system to be used for handicapping will be Southern California's PHRF. If you do not have a valid rating certificate from PHRF then see the Fleet Captain for a rating. Ratings will be taken from the Southern California PHRF handicaps. If Southern California PHRF does not have a rating for your boat then an average of the available PHRF ratings from other regions will be used. Non Spin Offsets will be used for the Non Spinnaker and Cruiser Classes.

### 4. Entries

Entry forms can be filled out online or on the dock at the competitor's meeting at Lake Mead Marina before Competitors meeting on the day of the race. Registration is closed after Competitors meeting on the day of the race. All competitors must register for the entire weekend if they wish to compete. Those that do not register, will NOT be allowed to compete in a single race.

### 5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions for the Lower Basin Regatta will be available at the competitors meeting before each race.

**7. Scoring**

At least one race must be sailed to constitute the series. The series will be scored using the RRS Appendix A Low Point System with the following designations and point assignments:

- o DSQ = # of starters + 2
- o DNC and DNS = # of boats in the series + 1
- o DNF, OCS = # of starters +1

If four or more races are sailed, one race will be discarded.

**8. Prizes**

Trophies will be awarded at the next Nevada Yacht Club end of the year party and trophy ceremonies

One trophy will be awarded for the Spring winner and one trophy will be awarded for the Fall winner with the overall winner of both races receiving the Ostrom Cup

**9. Other Information**

Lake Mead and the surrounding area is designated a National Recreation Area and as such is subject to the rules and regulations of the National Park Service.

All motorized vessels entering the park will be assessed a lake use fee charge. This includes vessels that are in dry storage and/or maintained in slips at the marinas.
